CRAFTSMAN - FACILITIES

JOB SUMMARY:

This incumbent is required to support the Facilities Maintenance Department by undertaking specialised trade work (electrical/plumbing/masonry/joinery/mechanical/welding) as well as occasional general maintenance work in and around the various facilities. He/she is to ensure that the general appearance and functionality of the building and surrounding areas especially with respect to their specific trade experience are properly maintained.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides feedback to direct reports on comments and issues facing the customer and other users of the facility
- Perform routine inspection and minor repairs (as per trade qualification or specific training)
- Troubleshoot and diagnose basic problems, provide solutions to recurring problems
- Perform maintenance and mechanical activities for assigned buildings and related facilities, furnishings and equipment (including painting, carpentry, plumbing, electrical, masonry, cement work, heating, welding, roofing and related work) in accordance with safe working practices
- Load, unload and move products and materials using hand or basic material handling equipment as part of the receiving, storage, issuing and dispatching process; transports materials, furniture and equipment to facilities
- Undertake general housekeeping of environs as directed by the Facility Manager/Supervisor
- Assist in the set up for events at SporTT facilities in a timely manner
- Conduct all duties in conformance with Health, Safety, Security & Environment (HSSE) requirements
- Oversee and direct work activity of all contractors and their agents that are responsible for setup and take down of equipment
- Ability to work and lead as part of a group of people, working toward solutions which generally benefit all involved parties
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with colleagues and members of the public
- Provide technical advice in the development of work scope/repair guidance for sporting equipment repairs
- Ability to express ideas orally or in writing in individual or group situations
- Write up and prepare service reports and daily job cards

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Training as evidenced by the possession of Five (5) CXC O'Level Passes including Mathematics and English or equivalent technical/vocational qualifications
- Apprenticeship or qualification/diploma in specific trade (i.e. Craftsman Certificate/Journeyman)
- Any equivalent combination of experience and training specific to trade experience
